



## Prospectus Basic Geology

### **Who should attend?**

This course is one of three courses that have been developed as part of a training programme to introduce non-graduate Geologists to the world of Geology. The course is aimed at providing a basic understanding of Geological processes and tasks as performed by an assistant or anyone needing a basic understanding of geology.

This course will also cover Unit Standards from the Mining Qualifications Authority (MQA) to enable Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) during further studies through the MQA and Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO).

### **Course outcomes**

On completion of the course, the learner will be able to successfully demonstrate:

- Measure and record the dip and strike of a plane – Unit Standard 254499
- Demonstrate an understanding of the principal mineral groups and their characteristics – Unit Standard 254501
