Who should attend?

This course is aimed at providing a fundamental understanding of stope tape measuring as performed by a Mineral Resource Department employee or anyone needing a basic understanding of tape measuring. This course will also cover Unit Standards from the MQA to enable Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) during further studies through the MQA and QCTO.
