



Prospectus Minerals Council – (COM) Certificates in Mine Surveying

Who should attend?

This course is ideally suited to candidates who are beginning or who are progressing with their Minerals Council (COM) Certificate training in mine surveying.

Course Content, Subjects and Duration

Theory and practical training – coaching of syllabus subjects, examination examples, examination techniques together with class/group problem solving of questions.
